6. Start order	The start sequence for the first task is drawn by lot. From the second task onwards, the top ten overall ranking will start in reverse order. Starting from position 11, the start is in the order of the overall placement.																		
7. Repeat starts	A pilot who has landed in the starting cylinder can start again. Restarters will be in the order in which they are reported to the start leader at the end of the Starter list classified.																		
8. Comp. Office	In the club house (low building) at the airfield.																		
9. Competition classes and titles	FAI 1 and FAI 5 (women and men) North-East German state championship HG 2022 If at least 3 female pilots take part in the competition, there will be a separate women's rating.

Participants	<p>The number of participants is limited to 55 pilots.</p> <p>National Championship North-East: 20 pilots, 4 of them women Pilots with permanent residence in the states of Niedersachsen, Nordrhein-Westfalen, Schleswig-Holstein, Hamburg, Bremen, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Sachsen-Anhalt, Sachsen, Thüringen, Brandenburg and Berlin.</p> <p>International open competition German Flatlands: National and international pilots: 20 pilots, 3 of them women</p> <p>Pilots from helper associations: 15 pilots (Pilots from clubs who support us with technology and helpers.)</p> <p>The competition management reserves the right to increase the contingent of participants or to occupy unoccupied places in the above-mentioned contingents in favor of other contingents after the deadline of February 15, 2022. The competition management also endeavours to keep 25% of the participant places available for international pilots in accordance with the rules of the FAI. In the event of early overbooking, there will be an early registration stop.</p> <p>The minimum number of participants is 35 pilots.</p>
15. Documentation	<p>The flights are documented via GPS track log with altitude recording. Each pilot has to bring his own cable for the download, a backup device is strongly recommended.</p> <p>Live trackers can be borrowed from the competition office.</p>
16. Scoring software	GpsDump, FS Comp
17. Scoring formula	<p>Current GAP-formula with the following settings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use Distance Points - Use Time Points - Use Arrival Position Points (only during Race) - Use Leading Points (only during Race)
18. Radios	<p>Radio equipment is recommended for participants. LPD and aeronautical radio are used at the airfield.</p>

20. Liability	<p>Each participant takes part in the competition at their own risk. Liability claims against the organizer, host, competition manager and his helpers will not be permitted in accordance with current legislation. (See liability disclaimer).</p>

Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Air sports equipment with type approval recognized in Germany • Prototype air sports equipment in accordance with <i>FAI Sporting Codes Sect. 7A, Edition 2020, for „uncertified gliders“ section 8.2 Airworthiness Standards of Hang Gliders</i>. Pilots must provide appropriate test protocol documentation. • Helmet tested in accordance with EN 966

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid license or foreign license, with additional endorsement for microlight tows launching. • Valid third party insurance • FAI-Sporting License 2022 (valid on the day of enrolment!) • Signed liability and participation agreement documents for DHV competitions. • All documents will be examined at registration. <p><i>The participants are also expected to be willing to help themselves to carry out smooth towing operations during the competition period outside their own launches.</i></p>

Start fee	<p>The entry fee is € 175,- and must be transferred after confirmed qualification (set to yellow in the DHV registration portal) by 03/15/2022 (receipt of payment!) at the latest.</p> <p>The registration only becomes effective upon receipt of the entry fee!</p> <p>After March 15, 2022, the seats that have not been paid for will be given to the pilots on the waiting list. The date of receipt of payment applies.</p> <p>If there are not enough pilots on the waiting list, registration and payment are still possible until the start of the competition, but from July 1st, 2022 an increased entry fee of € 200,- will be due.</p> <p>Please transfer the money to the following account:</p> <p>Drachenflieger-Club Berlin e.V. If the competition is not carried out for meteorological reasons, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.</p>
23. Included in start-fee	<p>Emergency medical care, pilot handout with all important telephone numbers and frequencies, evaluation, return coordination, pilot party with DJ and catering, trophies / cups.</p> <p>Breakfast at cost is offered daily!</p>
24. Tow charges	<p>The towing fees for the individual UL tows for each pilot are to be paid daily upon re-registration in addition to the entry fee. The towing fee is expected to be around € 30,- per tow at a height of 600 m above ground. The exact amount will be determined depending on the fuel costs before the start of the competition and communicated to the pilots.</p>

27. Retrieves	<p>Every Pilot is responsible for organizing his/her retrieve.</p>

28. Re-registration	Every participant must report back to the competition office immediately after landing by SMS and by means of a run report by the time indicated at the briefing. Every non-registered participant will be searched with all available means. The cost of the search will be billed to the participant.
