7. Repeat starts	A pilot who has landed in the starting cylinder can start again. Restarters will be in the order in which they are reported to the start leader at the end of the Starter list classified.

13. Participants	<p>The total number of participants is limited to 50 pilots. The minimum number of participants is 25 pilots.</p> <p>International open competition German Flatlands: National and international participants: 20 pilots.</p> <p>National Championship North-East: 20 pilots with permanent residence in the states of Niedersachsen, Schleswig-Holstein, Hamburg, Bremen, MecklenburgVorpommern, Sachsen-Anhalt, Sachsen, Thüringen, Brandenburg and Berlin. Simultaneous participation in the German Flatlands.</p> <p>Wildcards at the discretion of the organiser: 15 places (in particular for pilots from helper clubs)</p> <p>In the event of overbooking, participants will be selected according to their national points score and for foreign pilots according to WPRS points score or FAI regulations.</p> <p>The competition management reserves the right to increase the number of participants or to fill unpaid places in the above-mentioned contingents in favour of others after the deadline of May 31st, 2026.</p> <p>In the event of early overbooking, registration will be cancelled prematurely.</p>

Documentation	<p>The documentation of the flights takes place via live tracking with altitude recording, alternatively via upload on <i>dhv-xc.de</i></p> <p>The devices must be provided by the pilot, charged before each flight and switched on during the entire flight. A limited number of trackers can be hired on site for a weekly flat fee of €20. Please register in advance at <i>flatlandshg@dcb.org</i></p> <p>In exceptional cases (or if there is insufficient live data), the evaluation can alternatively be carried out via GPS track log with altitude recording if the device is handed in to the scorer by 8pm.</p> <p>(Every pilot should bring a cable for the download, a backup device is recommended)</p>

16. Scoring formula	<p>Current GAP- competitive formula with the following settings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use Distance Points - Use Time Points - Use Arrival Position Points (only for Race) - Use Leading Points (only for Race)
17. Competition Classes and Scores	<p>FAI 1 and -5 International German-Flatlands Winner (women and men) 2026,</p> <p>If at least 3 female pilots take part in the competition, there will be a separate women's classification.</p> <p>North-East German National Championship HG, FAI 1 & 5, 2026.</p>

18. Radio	Radio equipment is recommended for participants. LPD and aeronautical radio are used at the airfield.

Pilots must provide appropriate test protocol documentation. • Helmet tested in accordance with EN 966 • Valid license or foreign license • Eligibility for microlight tow launch • Valid third party insurance • FAI-Sporting License 2026 (valid on the day of enrolment) • Signed liability and participation agreement documents for DHV competitions. <p>All documents will be examined at registration.</p> <p><i>The participants are also expected to be willing to help themselves to carry out smooth towing operations during the competition period outside their own launches.</i></p>

<p>22. Start fee</p>	<p>The entry fee is € 200. Registration only becomes effective upon receipt of the entry fee by May 31st, 2026.</p> <p>After June 16th, 2026, the places not paid for by then (the date of receipt of payment applies) will be allocated to the pilots on the waiting list. (Exceptions in case of illness and only with medical certificate)</p> <p>If the competition is not held for meteorological reasons, 50% of the entry fee</p>

<p>23. Included in startfee</p>	<p>Rescue medical care, pilot handouts with all important telephone numbers and frequencies, t-shirt, evaluation, retrieval coordination, pilot party, trophies/cups</p> <p>Breakfast at cost price is offered daily!</p>
<p>24. Tow charges</p>	<p>The towing fees for the individual UL tows of each pilot are calculated daily. The towing fee is expected to be €40 per tow at an altitude of 600 metres above ground.</p> <p>It is obligatory to pay towing fees for <u>3 tows (€120) in advance</u> at the time of enrolment or by bank transfer.</p> <p>Unused advance payments will be refunded!</p>

<p>26. GPS- Registrierung</p>	<p>Monday July 27th, 2026, from 5pm to 8pm at the competition office.</p> <p>After each task, please return the GPS devices (including the backup) and any live trackers as early as possible and by 8pm!</p>
<p>27. Retrieves</p>	<p>Each pilot is responsible for the retrieval himself!</p> <p>A return coordination of the organizer will be set up if necessary.</p>

28. Re-registration	Immediately after landing, each participant must report back to the competition office via SMS and run report by the time stated in the briefing. Any unregistered participant will be searched with all available means. The costs of the search campaign will be charged to the participant.
